

OUR MISSION

To establish and maintain a comprehensive community service agency with a diversified funding source that will serve the needs of veterans, their families, and other needy individuals of the community.

Launched in San Antonio, Texas in 1972, the American G.I. Forum National Veterans Outreach Program (AGIF-NVOP) first sought to reach out to disenfranchised veterans of the Vietnam War by engaging other Vietnamera veterans to communicate the availabilty of local resources and services for ex-military personnel. The initiative struggled with various hurdles early on, the most significant of which is funding, but eventually gained critical support from other veterans service organizations as well as influential community and civic leaders. Since 1972 we, the NVOP, have remain committed to needs of the under served veteran populations.

PROGRAMS OFFERED

The NVOP employs trained case managers who provide job search assistance. Case Managers assist veterans with developing an individualized action plan to address the needs and employment goals of the veteran. This service includes a basic skills assessment, resume building, interviewing skills and working directly with employers seeking to hire veterans. The NVOP utilizes a network of service providers, educational facilities, and employers to meet the needs and goals of our veterans. Requirements for Service from the American GI Forum National Veterans Outreach Program, Inc.

Veterans needing job assessment, job training and placement can use resources available from the NVOP that are specifically tailored to address their critical needs.

Applicants must be veterans who have been discharged from active military service and under other than dishonorable conditions.

Veterans interested in Job Training or Job Placement services offered by NVOP must provide the following documentation:

- DD FORM-214
- Proof of Citizenship
- Social Security Card
- State/Federal Photo ID
