Fire up Your Future With the My Career Advancement Account

Getting the job or career you want often starts with education, and covering tuition costs can be difficult. The **My Career Advancement Account Scholarship** is a workforce development program that provides up to \$4,000 of tuition assistance to eligible military spouses. The scholarship assists military spouses in pursuing licenses, certificates, certifications or associate degrees necessary to gain employment in high-demand, high-growth portable career fields and occupations. STEP 1

Confirm your eligibility

- Your spouse is on active duty, in the National Guard or reserves on Title 10 military orders in pay grades E1-E5, W1-W2 or O1-O2.
- You need to request tuition assistance while your military sponsor is on Title 10 military orders.
- You have successfully completed high school.

STEP 2

Talk with a SECO career coach – 800-342-9647

- Discover your strengths, interests and capabilities, and learn which jobs are best for you.
- Develop an individual career plan, or [MyICP](#), based on your background, experience, challenges and growth opportunities, and the type of job you'd like. Your plan provides customized tools, resources and activities to help you meet your career goals.

STEP 3

Register for a My Career Advancement Account

Log on to the My Career Advancement Account Scholarship website.

- Find the school that is right for you.
- Get started on your education.

The My Career Advancement Account Scholarship is part of the Department of Defense Spouse Education and Career Opportunities program that offers comprehensive coaching, information, tools and resources to support military spouse career exploration, education, training and licensing, employment readiness and career connections.

A DS Logon is required to create an account on the My Career Advancement Account. The Department of Defense Self-Service Logon is a secure, self-service logon ID that allows Department of Defense and Veteran Affairs affiliates to access several websites using a single username and password. The DS Logon is also used to access other online services, like TRICARE or MySECO. [Log in or sign up to get started.](#)
